Subject: Revisions to Article 31 and Article 13 of the FY 2009 Supplemental Appropriation Act (09-H-5019)

The Governor requests a change to Article 31 of the FY 2009 Supplemental Appropriations Act. There is no bottom line change in expenditures to the budget reflected in Article 1. The mid-year revisions for Group Home Aid were omitted from the figures in the community by community list.

The Governor also requests that the effective date of Article 13 be changed from February 1, 2009 to January 1, 2009. This change is required to allow the Tax Administrator to legally withhold the 2nd quarter one-cent environmental protection regulatory fee receipts from the Underground Storage Tank Financial Responsibility Fund. The amendments requested to both of these articles are shown below:
