Subject: Amendments to Article 17 of the FY 2013 Appropriations
Act (12-H-7323)

The Governor requests that Article 17 – Relating to Medical Assistance – Dental Benefits be removed from the FY 2013 Appropriations Act. This will require the restoration of general revenue appropriations of \$2.7 million and federal funds appropriation of \$2.9 million, both of which will be reflected in amendments to Article 1 to be submitted as a separate request. Subsequent to the submission of the Governor’s original budget, the Office of Health and Human Services was able to obtain an agreement with Neighborhood Health Plan to provide a contribution to the state in the amount of \$1.8 million for the adult dental program. As a result of this contribution and the important nature of this service, the Governor requests that this program be restored in its entirety.
