

## **Department of Transportation Stimulus-Funded Employment Positions**

The Department of Transportation is posting 89 positions to support stimulus-funded projects over the next several weeks. In fact, on Thursday, March 5th, DOT will advertise for a civil service examination for the position of Engineering Tech I (47 entry level positions). All of the positions listed are federally funded under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The following is a breakdown of the positions along with the salary ranges:
